- 2018:Revivify America introduces the Revivify coating line to the USA, revolutionizing paint protection.



Therefore, it's not recommended to take a vehicle with a traditional ceramic coating through a car wash, as it can damage the coating and compromise its protective qualities.

Silicone Powder vs. Quartz Base

Look at the protective cover of your cell phone. It's silicone based. This allows it to absorb the impact if you drop it, thereby protecting the actual phone from breaking. That's the primary difference between Revivify and ceramic coatings – a silicone base vs. a quartz base. Nanotechnology makes this possible.

Car Washes

Automatic car washes that use brushes or other material that actually touch the vehicle actually harm your vehicles clear coat by making micro scratches in it. Over time this will result in a dull looking appearance. We do not recommend using these types of car washes, even if you have a Revivify coating because over time it will cause deterioration of the coating. A touch-free car wash may be used; however, the cheap soap they use can damage the coating over time. If you do use a touch-free car wash, wipe it down with a rinseless wash product to ensure you remove residue and hard water deposits.



Material and Labor Costs

The cost of high-quality coatings is approximately \$11.00 per milliliter, and it takes approximately 100 ml to coat an average car. Additional material costs include washing, decontamination, claying, paint correction, polishing, decontaminating again, and applying the coating, resulting in material costs exceeding \$1,000. Then you have to 15 hours of labor and overhead, and that comes out to a big number.

Compare to Wax

Compare the cost of a coating to waxing over a five-year period, and it's more economical to coat your vehicle than wax it. This assumes a \$300 cost to wax a car, 3 times a year for 5 years.
